CAUTION

Potentially Dangerous Dogs

BEWARE - It has been reported to the BSLPOA Board of Directors and Office Staff that there are two potentially dangerous dogs roaming around in the area of Cape Horn and Acapulco Circle.

When walking alone or with your dog, riding bicycles, jogging, or golf cart usage in this general area, please exercise as much caution as possible until the situation is rectified. Avoid the area if at all possible. Animal Control has been notified and will be providing baited traps in an effort to catch and remove the dogs. It is reported that they are either pit bulls or pit bull/boxer mix (one male and one female). They are considered dangerous. Some of our residents have experienced encounters with the dogs.

We have a call into the Sheriff's Office to assist in this endeavor. We will follow up with another announcement when the animals have been captured. Do not hesitate to call Charlotte County Animal Control at 764-4320 to report a sighting or encounter.
