LITTORAL PLANTING UPDATE

Thanks to recent cooperative rains increasing the water levels, our lakes are deemed ready to begin Littoral plantings.

Barring unforeseen events, Aquatics Systems, our lakes quality contractor, plans to begin planting on **Monday July 23, 2007** and complete the project within 3-5 days. A brisk schedule will be followed in order to protect the littorals from shock in between harvesting and planting in the new location.

For this reason, it is **imperative** that property owners place orange flags (available at the office) near the water's edge. The flag locations should generally define the area in which you prefer the plants installed. Should you desire a "gap" in between plantings, allowing for future "fill-in growth" or just for personal aesthetics, please mark your flags to note the planting area. For example, begin with a flag marked 'A' at your property line and mark a second flag with an 'A' twenty feet away. Pace off the desired empty space and use 'B' s to mark the next twenty foot section. If your plantings are to be in one contiguous segment, just place one flag at each end of the "planting strip".

The flags must be marked and in place prior to planting. Due to the vigorous schedule intended by the project manager, Les Stevens, it will not be possible to contact all property owners for in-put by telephone.
