



**Community Notification #2008 – 01a - Update
(Issued 03/17/2008)**

CHARLOTTE COUNTY WATER RESTRICTIONS

The Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) has extended its Phase II Water Shortage Order through June 30, 2008, limiting lawn watering to once per week throughout the 16-county district. (From the Sun-Herald 2/24/08.)

The once per week schedule applies to all commercial and residential properties and to all water sources: *public and private utilities, wells, canals, lakes, etc.*

If your address (or house number) ends in:

0 or 1 - Water only on Monday

2 or 3 - Water only on Tuesday

4 or 5 - Water only on Wednesday

6 or 7 - Water only on Thursday

8 or 9* - Water only on Friday

* and locations without a discernible address

Personal vehicle washing is limited to once per week. Any hose used should have a shut off nozzle.

Power washing is allowed to remove mold from roofs and driveways or to remove paint in preparation of re-painting.
