The Safety & Preparedness Committee is currently working on an emergency response plan for our community. The plan involves development of a skills inventory noting residents with experience in first aid, fire safety, medical operations such as assessment, treatment and hygiene or triage and treating life threatening injuries, as well as light search and rescue, team organization or construction, ability to move or haul heavy objects such as downed trees, ham radio or other skills necessary for deployment as needed.

A natural disaster such as a hurricane tornado, flood or wildfire can easily overwhelm our County's professional response services. A prepared community is able to provide immediate assistance to sustain life following a disaster and direct emergency personnel to areas or persons with the highest level of need.
